Two locations:

<u>Luce Creek</u>: meet at the end of Washington Drive, which is off Lincoln Parkway, the street intersecting Bestgate near the 7/11.

<u>Picture Springs Branch</u>: meet at The Place, 8318 Telegraph Road (Rt. 170), Odenton, across from the new Academy Yard apartments.

When?

Saturday, April 5th from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm, rain or shine!

Who?

We need at least 100 people, ages 16 and up! Sorry, but these sites are not child friendly as the largest quantities of trash are on steep slopes. All cleanup supplies will be provided, but if you have favorite, comfortable work gloves feel free to bring them. Don't forget sturdy shoes, important for this site's terrain.

Why?

This effort is part of the Alliance for the Chesapeake Bay's annual effort, Project Clean Stream. Project Clean Stream volunteers improve their community by removing trash, tires and other discarded items from area streams and nearby roadsides. In 2013, there were 200 sites and over 5,000 volunteers removed approximately 300,000 pounds of trash from area streams!
