Former Senator Gerald Winegrad has devoted himself to environmental causes for 50 years. He will examine the results of 37 years of formal efforts to restore the Chesapeake Bay, based on limiting nutrients and sediment that cause dead zones and impact living resources. You will learn from an expert insider on the successes and failures in achieving these goals and impediments to further progress. The former Senator will pull no punches in revealing some inconvenient truths about restoring the Bay.

Gerald is an attorney with 50 years of experience in environmental advocacy. He served with distinction in the Maryland Legislature for 16 years, in the House of Delegates and then as a State Senator from 1983 to 1995 representing the greater Annapolis area. Gerald writes a weekly environmental column in The Capital newspaper. He lives on Oyster Creek and is an active birder and crabber.
